Introduced in 1925 as a successor to the long lived and enormously successful Silver Ghost, the 40/50hp New Phantom was still a little outdated in concept although featured the all-new pushrod operated overhead valve engine with detachable cylinder heads. A total of 2,258 were built.

In 1926, Lady Mary Fitzmaurice of Leighton Buzzard, spent an extra £32/15/- to have all of the brightwork on her Rolls Royce 'New Phantom' 1926 series A2B in silverplate. She had already paid £1,850 for the chassis, specifying for the long-wheelbase chassis to be fitted with a 2/4 seater Barker body, and to have the car's speedometer calibrated in both kilometers and miles per hour. A spare wheel was to be mounted on the rear. In 1933, the car was traded back to Rolls Royce Ltd., for £185, by Lady Mary Gosling, before being on-sold to Jack Barclay. At this point it was fitted with formal bodywork that was more suitable for vice-regal duties in an Indian posting.

In the late 1930's the car, together with a group of similar cars, arrived in Melbourne from India. The cars all arrived as bare chassis, the bodies having been discarded at sea to avoid the payment of import duties. Martin & King then rebodied the car with a standardised 4-door saloon body for taxi and hire car work. It is likely that six wheel equipment was fitted then. After service in this area, it became an outback hawker's runabout. During the 1950's the car languished in a shed near a kiosk on St.Kilda pier before being acquired as a restoration project. Soon after, the car was bought by the late Stuart Middlehurst of Drouin, who disposed of the decrepit body and then mounted a 4-5 seater sporting tourer body by Kellow-Falkiner, from his 30HP Minerva. A converted windscreen from a Stutz Bearcat was also fitted. Although these modifications were structurally sound, the current body was never finished with regard to the upholstery, trim, side curtains, hood, or to the reinstallation of the R-R pattern of wiring and fittings, however the electrical wiring and equipment is reasonably complete and fully functional. The primary concern had been to get the vehicle roadworthy and running.

The vehicle was acquired by the present owners in 1963.
