

## MOTORING MEMORABILIA

**"THE JOHN BULL COLLECTION".**

**John Bull (15.2.37 - 20.10.96) was an Adelaide artist who specialized in drawing prestigious British cars, especially Rolls-Royce and Armstrong Siddeley's. He was a very active member of the South Australian branches of both the Rolls-Royce and Armstrong Siddeley car clubs and was editor of the newsletter for the Rolls-Royce club. His sketches and illustrations were well known throughout Australia and the World. He contributed his illustrations to several books most notably Martin Bennett's "Rolls-Royce and Bentley, The Crewe Years". He took a particular interest in distinctive coachwork and his illustrations reveal a particular admiration for that of Hooper's. He had an extended correspondence with Osmand Rivers, Chief designer for Hooper's and he took a pride in the quality of his writing and his correspondence with others was also engaging and informative.**
