The book, used for composition, spelling and dictation, has been notated on front in an adult hand <i>"Has had only 12 mths school of a white childs time...1 hour a day."</i> The dictation for 2nd Oct. refers to a trip to <i>"the Pumping Station"</i> with <i>"Mr and Mrs Lupton"</i> [Harry & Ethyl Lupton, who were missionaries at Mt. Margaret in the 1930s]. <i>"...all the girls made a big fire and other girls looked for Quandongs."</i> Other compositions involve princesses, asking Santa Claus for a new boat, a conversation between a kettle and a saucepan, riding on an elephant, etc. An extremely rare and fascinating insight into the education offered at the Mission, "The school's achievements in numeracy and literacy were widely lauded and set Mount Margaret apart from other missions of the period."
